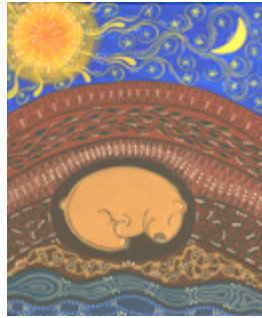


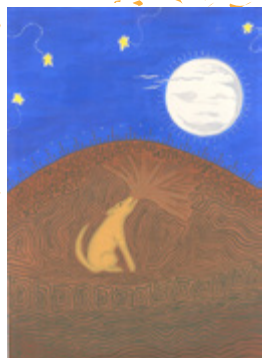
AUSTRALIAN ANIMALS FACT SHEET

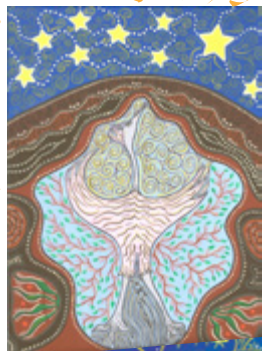
Wombat

Some children are just like the wombat. They are the dreamers who inspire us with their imagination and wonder. They are exceptional children and wise beyond their years.



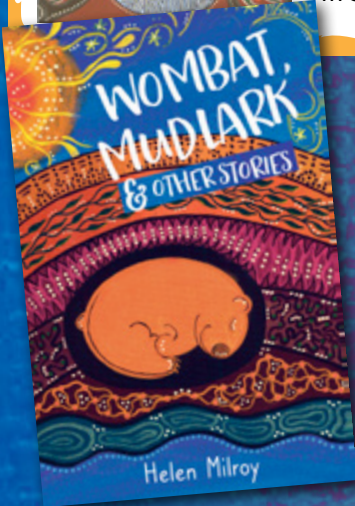
Dingo
