Deep in the heart of the city, Frankie dreams of a thousand trees. Help Frankie green-up the world!

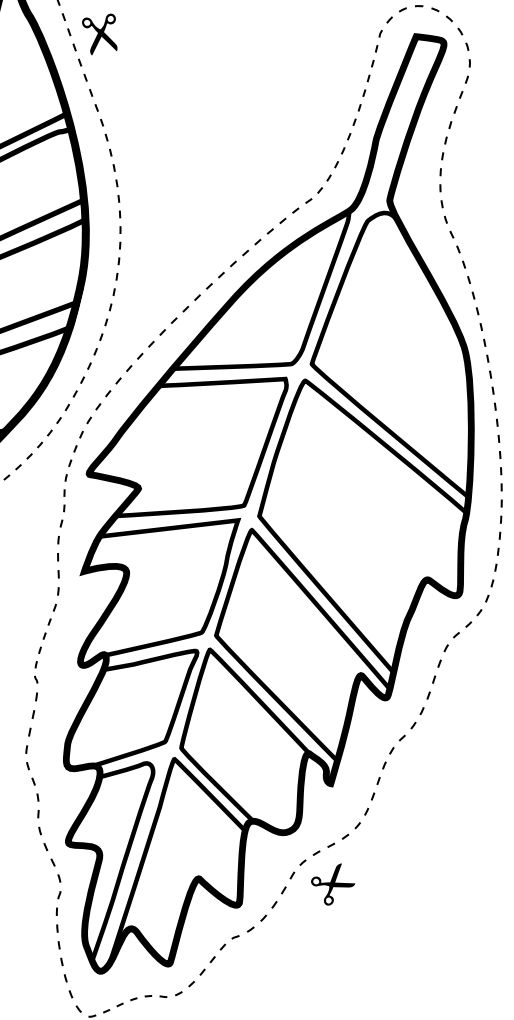
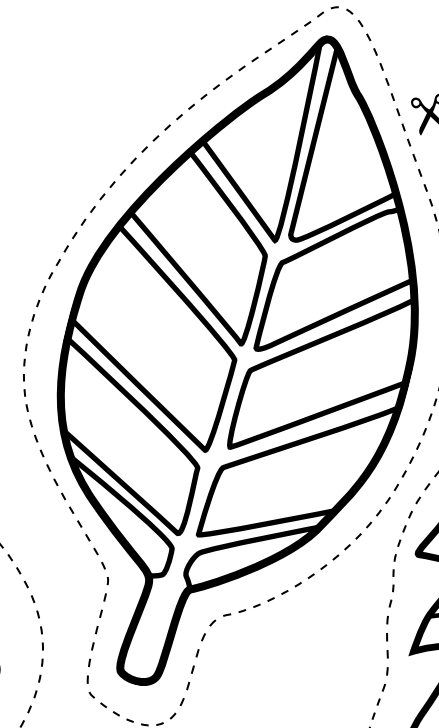
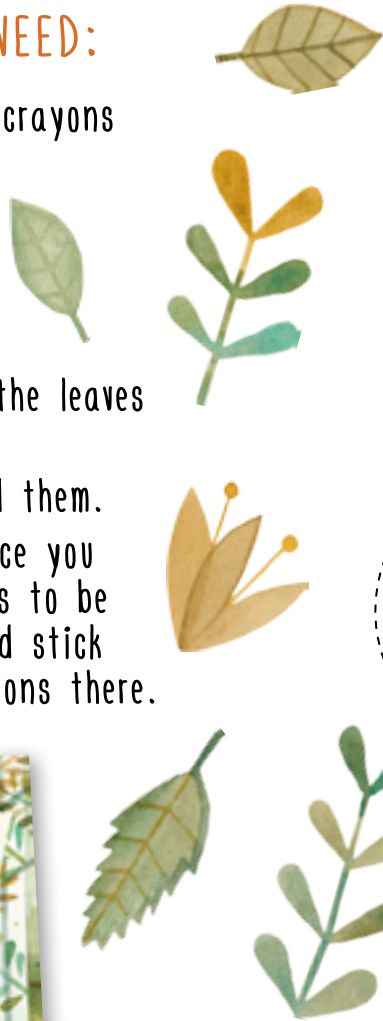


YOU WILL NEED:

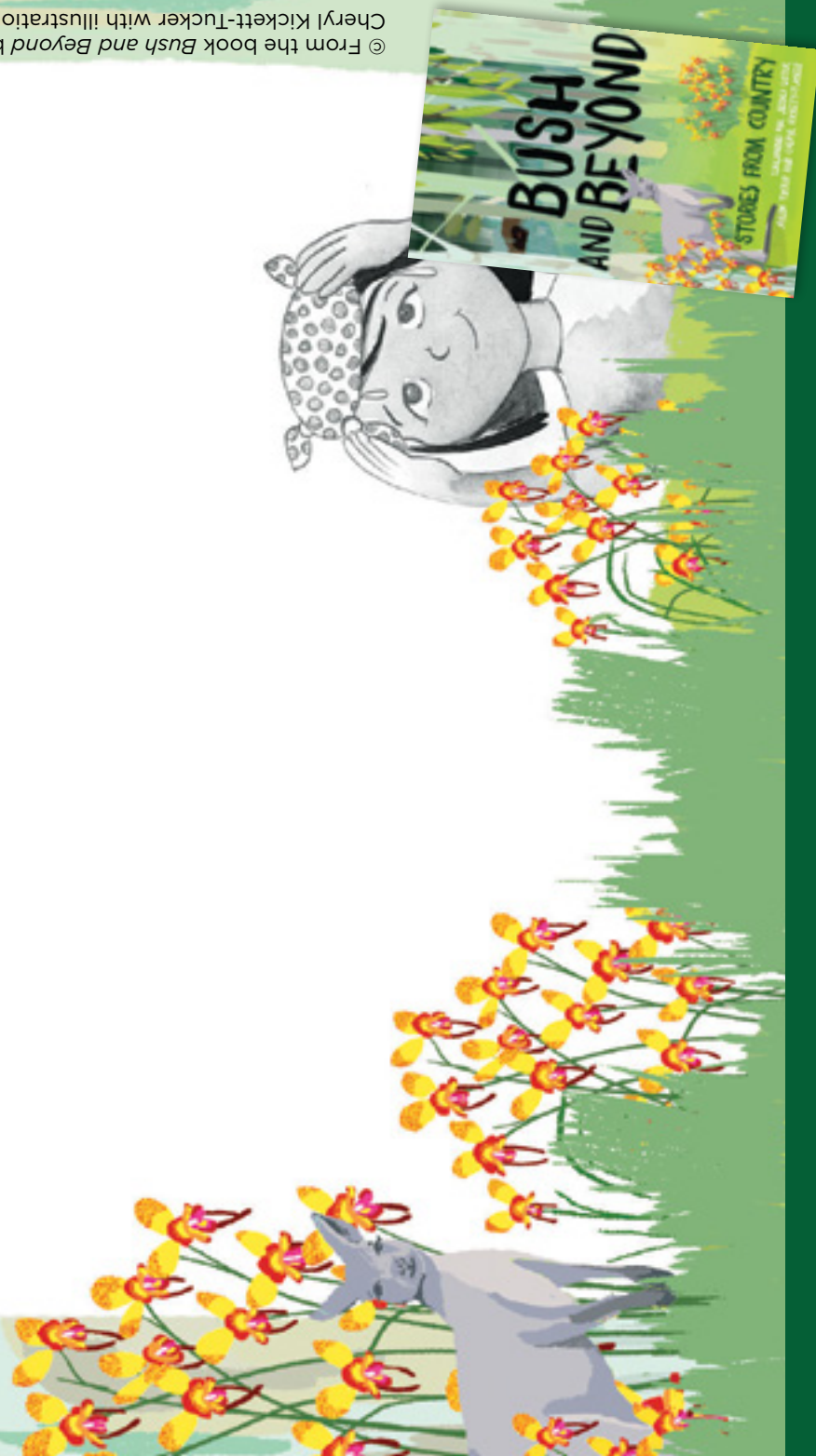
