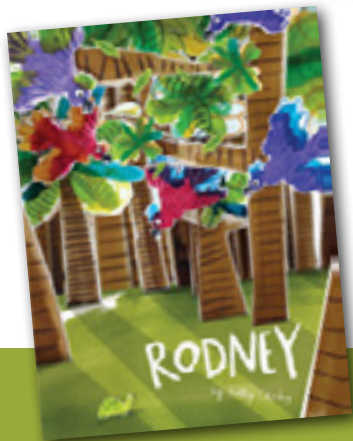
Who is the Smallest and who is the Tallest?

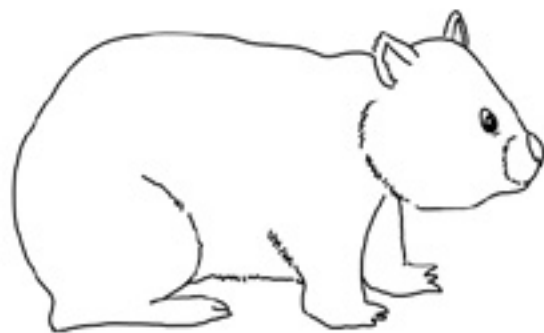
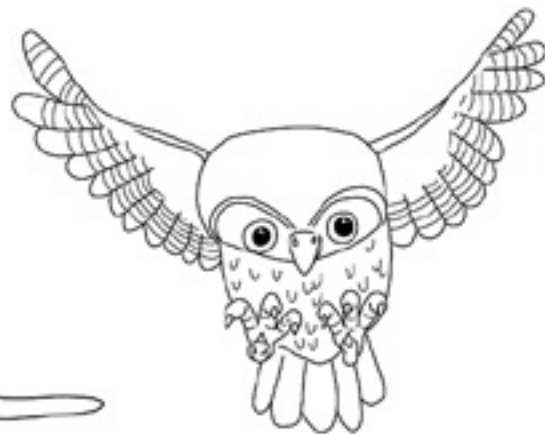


What colour are these Aussie animals?

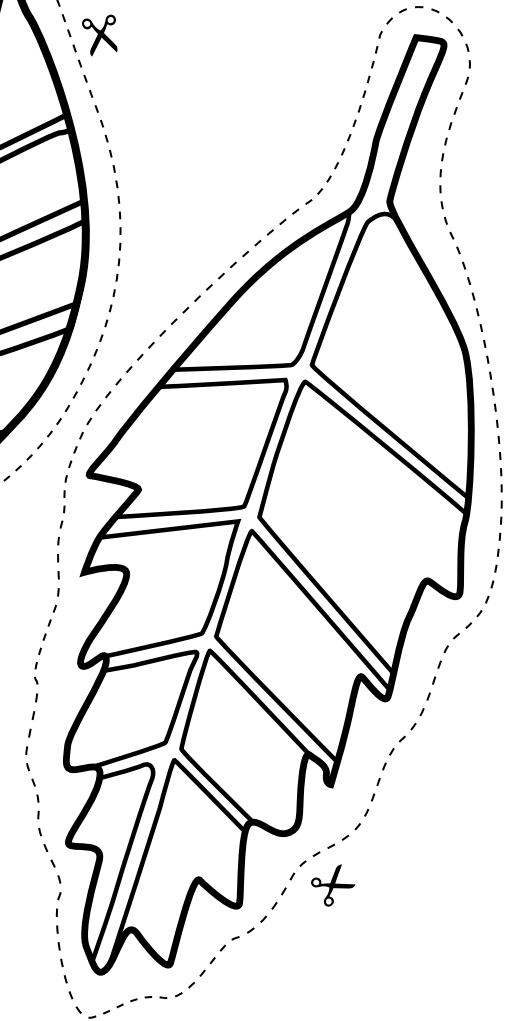
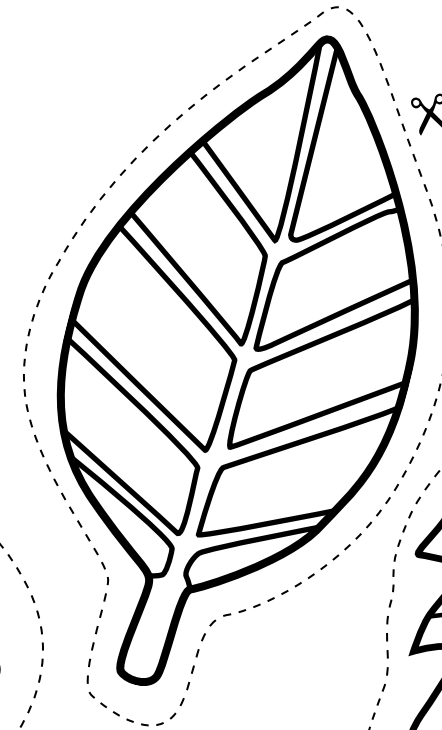


YOU WILL NEED:
