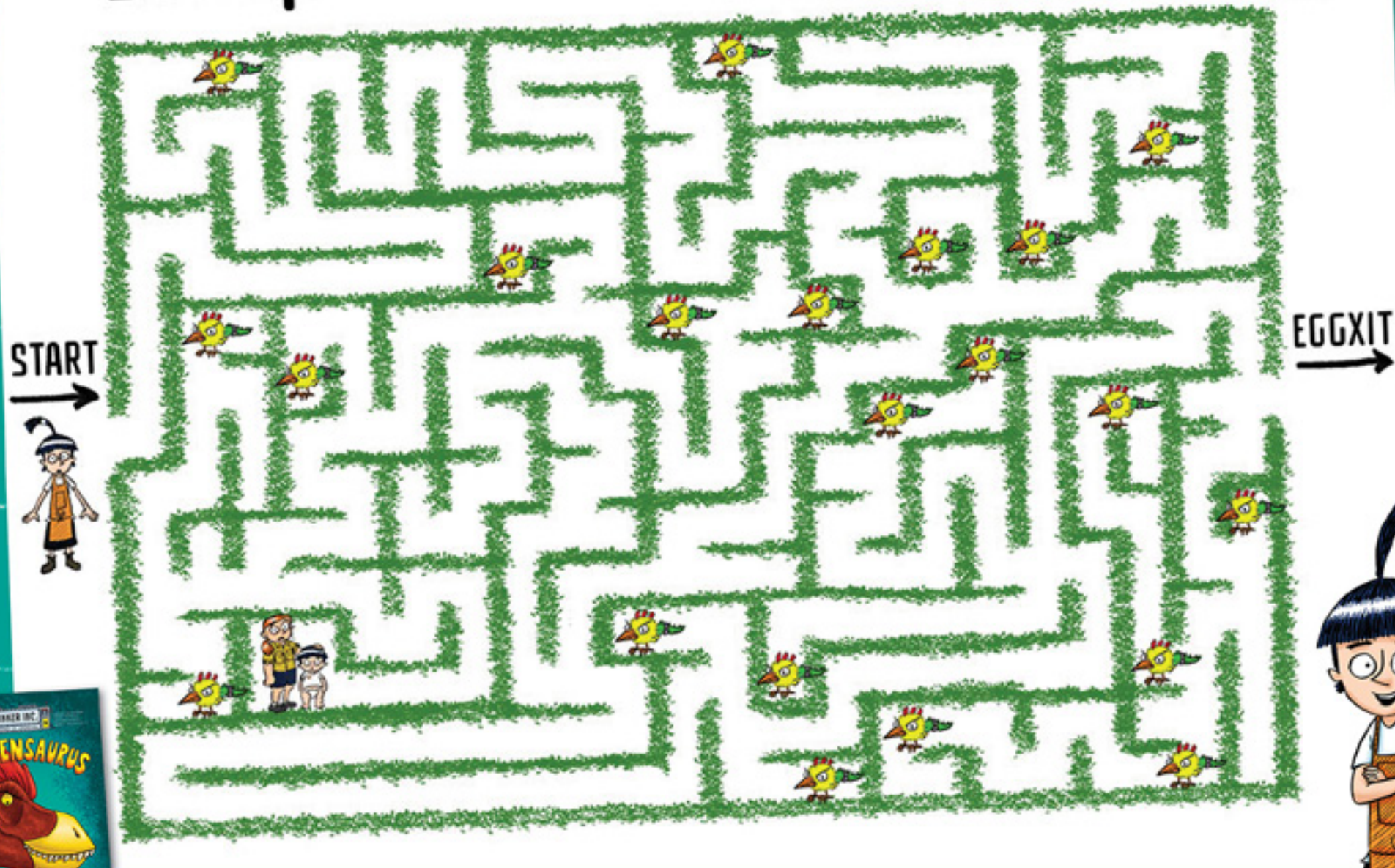

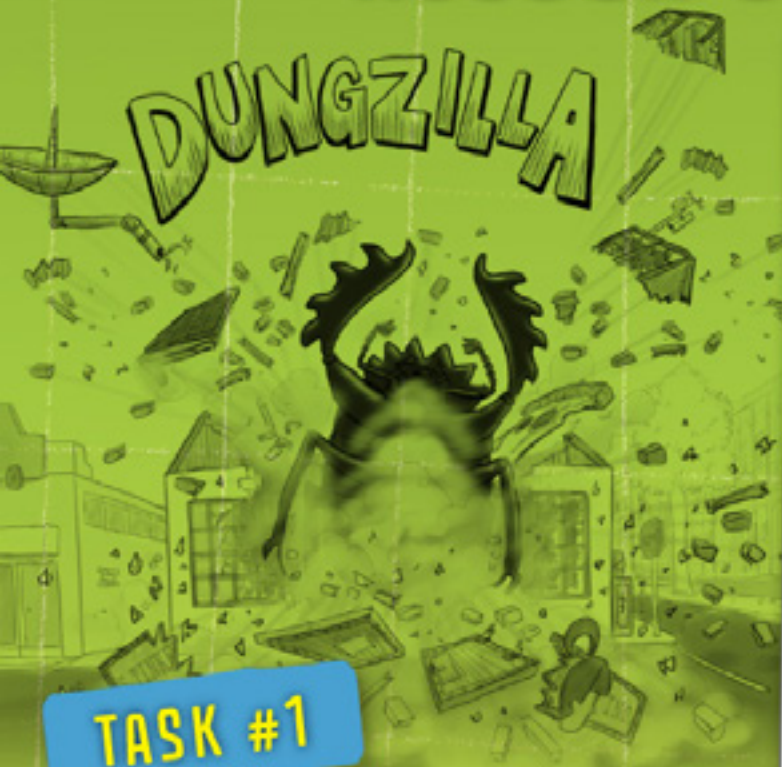

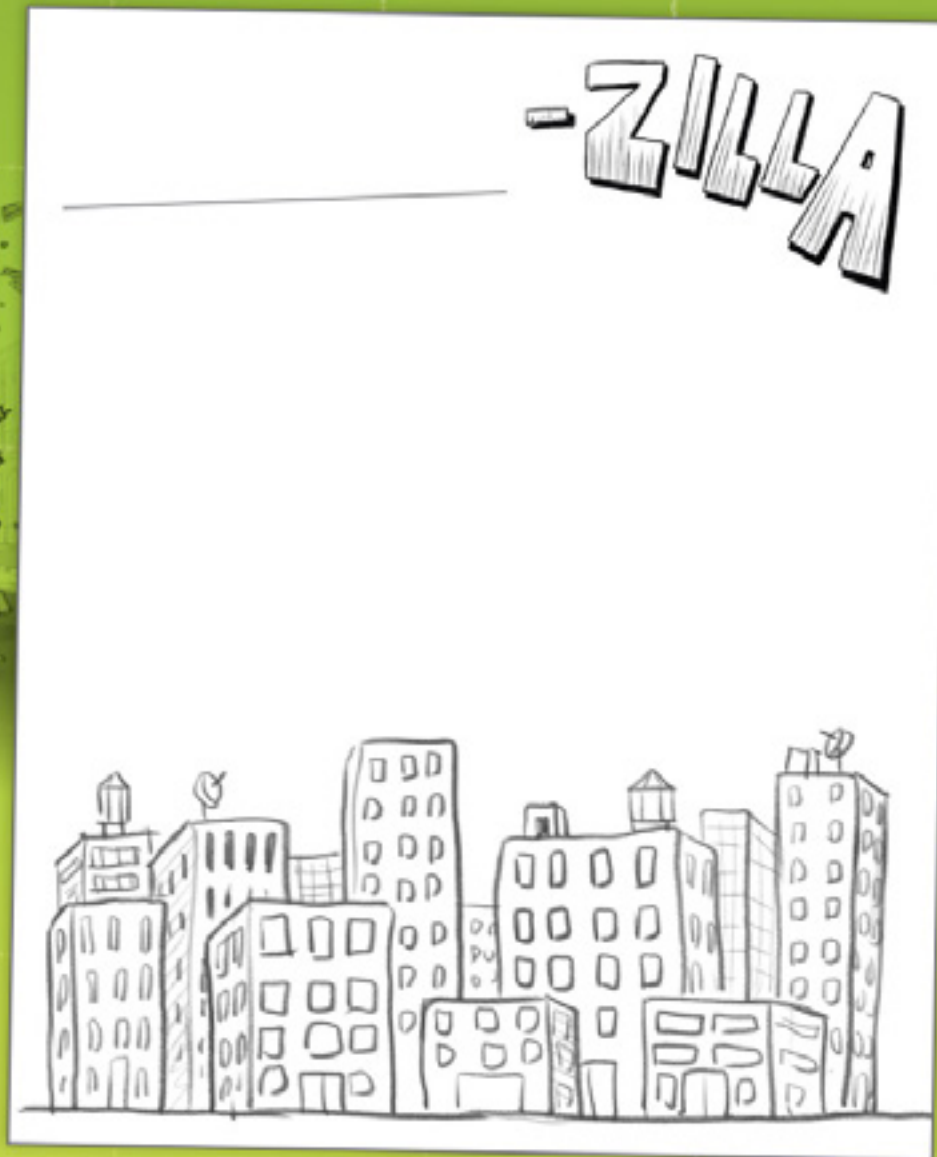
TASK #1

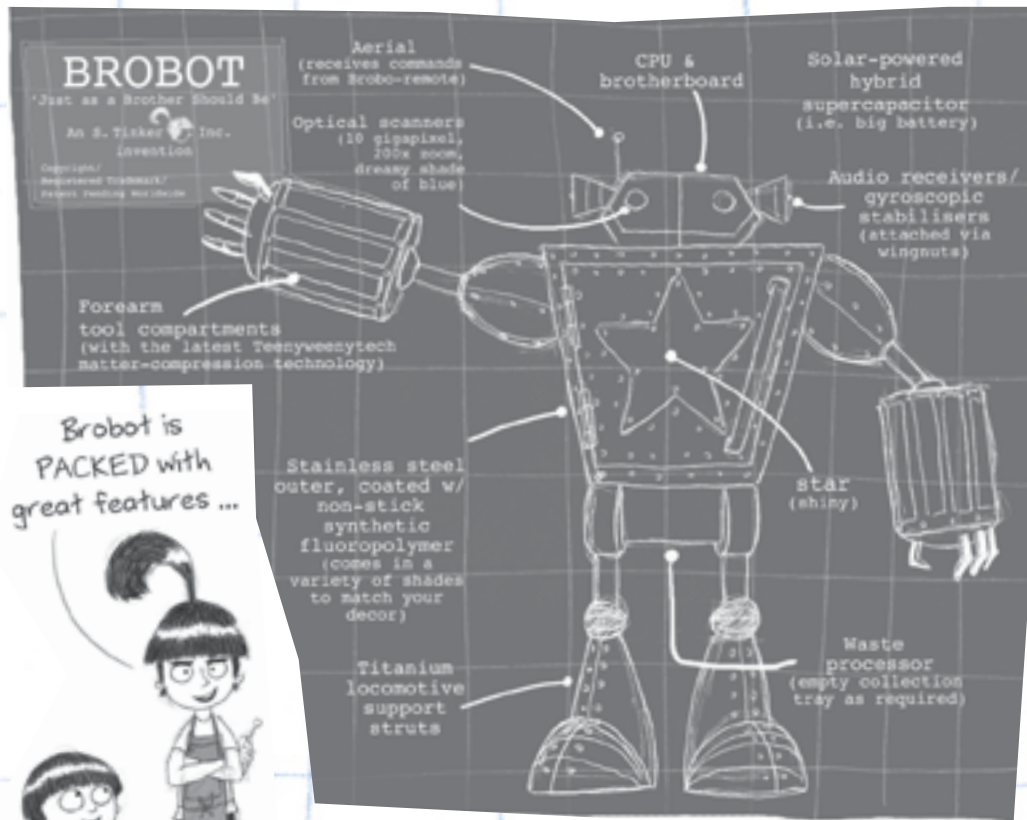
