Sixteen years later, another case brings Snowy to Broome, where he teams up with Dan Clement (*Before It Breaks*) and an incidental crime puts them back on the Claremont case. *Clear to the Horizon* is a nail-biting Aussie-style thriller, based on one of the great unsolved crimes in Western Australia's recent history. Its twists and turns will keep you guessing to the end.

Dave Warner is the author of a number of novels and non-fiction books. He also writes for the screen, where he has produced feature films and television credits. He led the band Dave Warner's from the Suburbs which, released a number of acclaimed albums in the 1970s and 80s.


