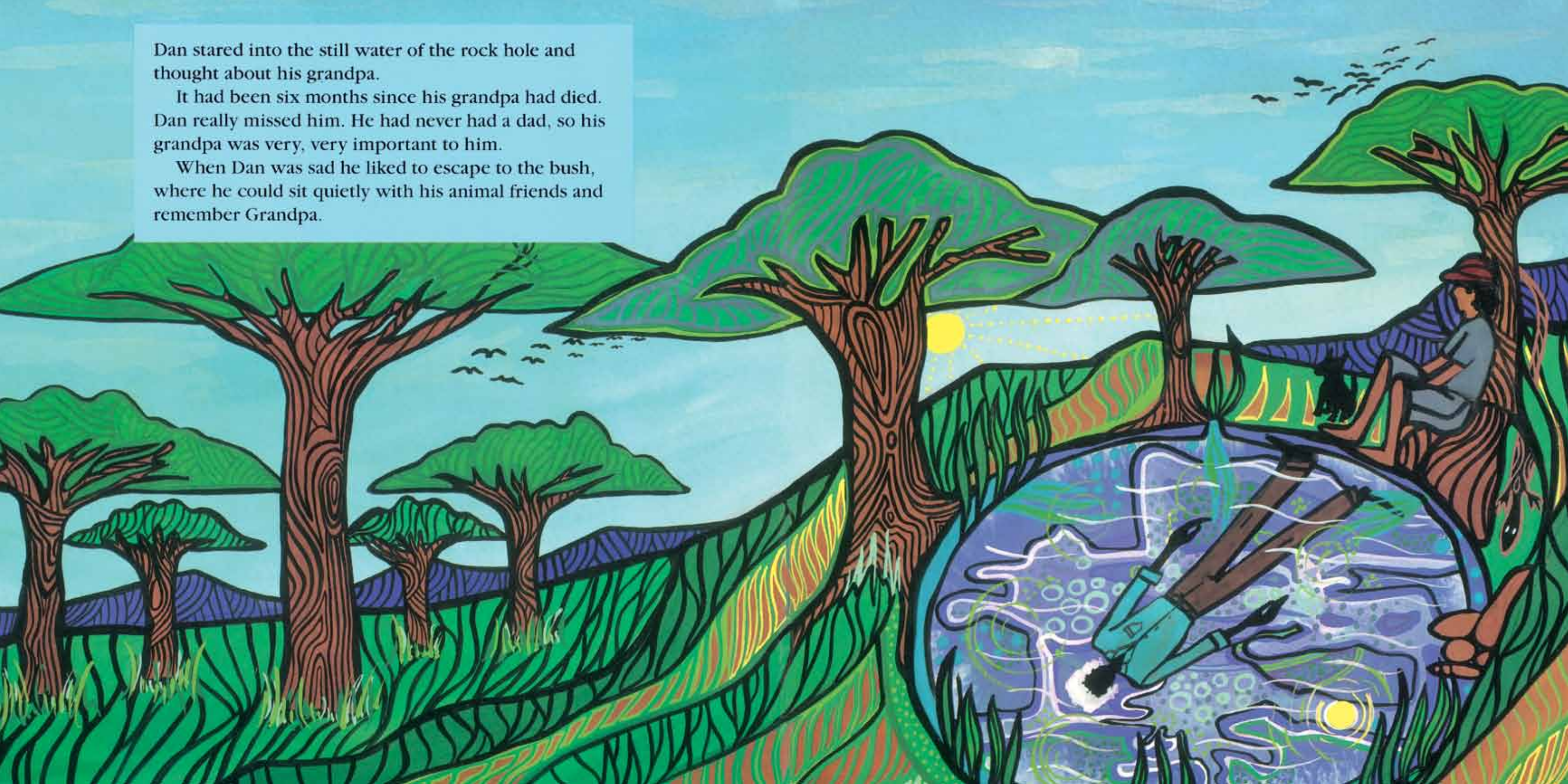

Dan stared into the still water of the rock hole and thought about his grandpa.

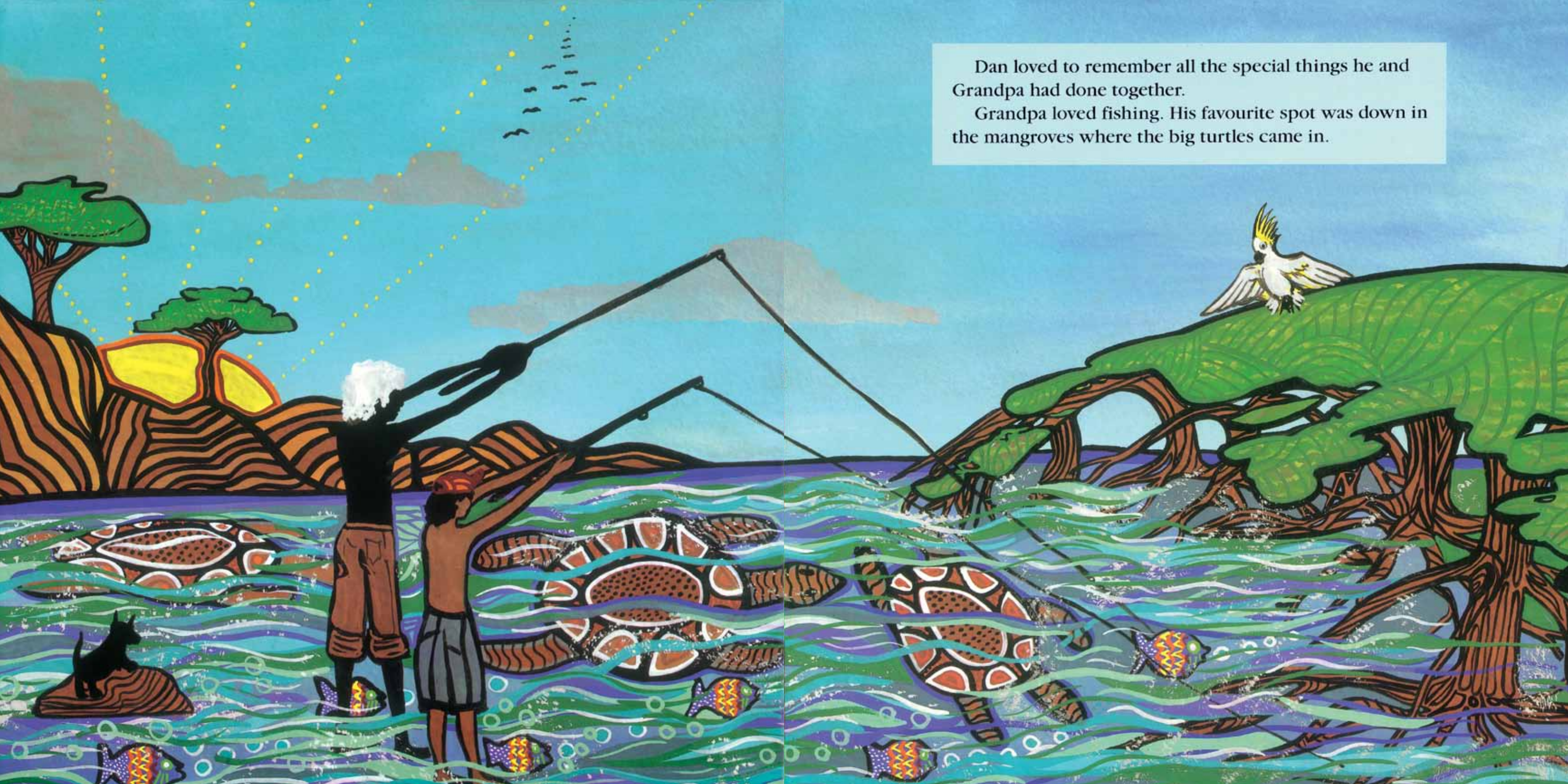
It had been six months since his grandpa had died. Dan really missed him. He had never had a dad, so his grandpa was very, very important to him.
