## WHaT You WILL NeeD

- 1. A torch
- 2. Toilet roll tubes
- 3. Sticky tape
- 4. A pin
- 5. A dark place with a blank wall

## MeTHoD

- 1. Cut out the constellation cards.
- 2. Using your pin, make a hole in each of the stars.
- 3. Place your constellation cards face down over the end of your toilet roll tube and secure with sticky tape.
- 4. Shine your torch through the back of the toilet roll tube to project the constellations onto the wall.
