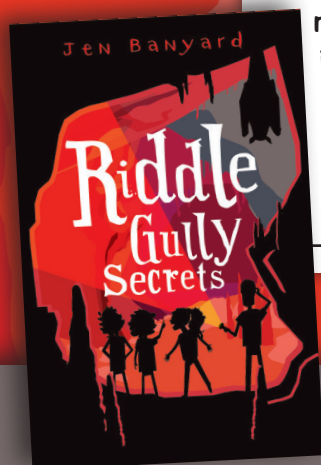
I recruited children for armed hold-ups and shoot-outs with the police. Tom Roberts painted a picture with me in it. I am famous for escaping from Cockatoo Island.
