ABOUT THE BOOK

With ex-ballet dancers as parents, fourteen-year-old Amelia's whole world revolves around dance. Her sights are set on becoming a professional ballerina and she won't let anything, or anyone, get in her way.

Valentina's the new kid at the Academy and Amelia's biggest competition. She recently migrated to Australia from a tiny town in Italy's south, where tradition is valued above all else. Girls aren't supposed to grow up to be ballerinas, but Valentina is determined to do just that.

Set in an elite dance academy, *One Wrong Turn* is a compelling coming-of-age novel depicting the athleticism and resilience required of dancers.


ABOUT THE AUTHOR
