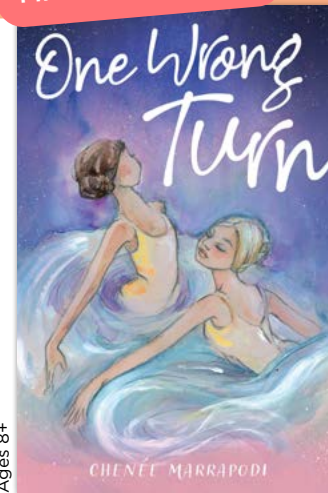

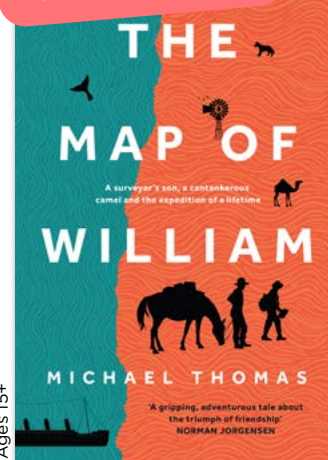

## THE MAP OF WILLIAM

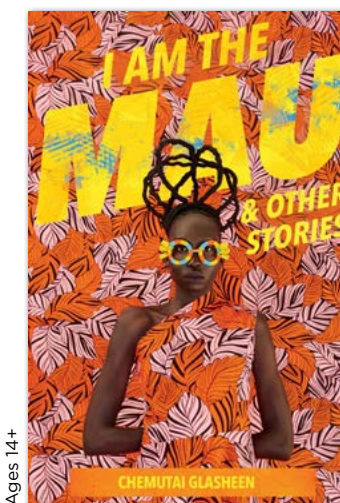

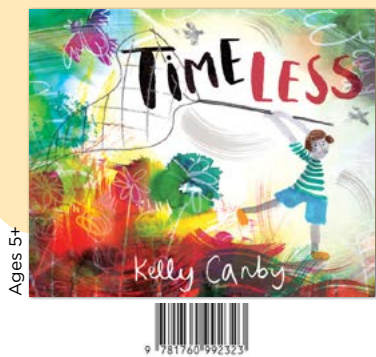
**SAY HOORAY**
