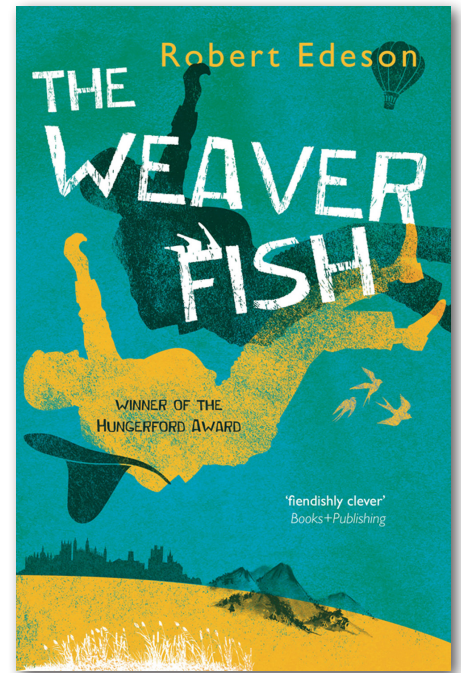
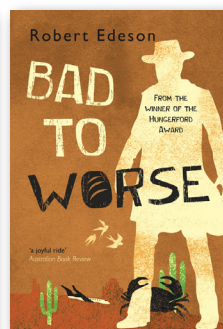
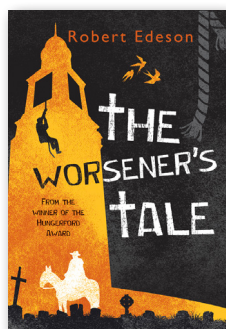
- *The Weaver Fish* is more than a novel. For code breakers, mathematicians and lovers of the cryptic crossword, this novel is also one great puzzle to solve.
