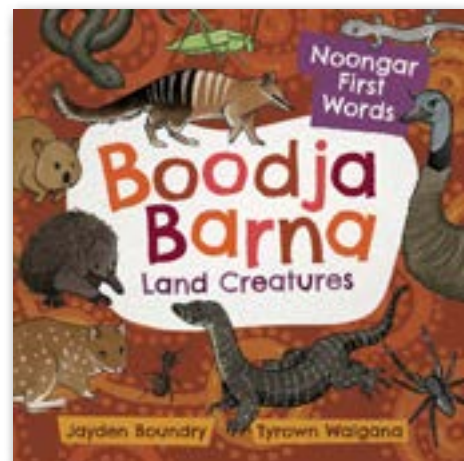
ABOUT THE ILLUSTRATOR
