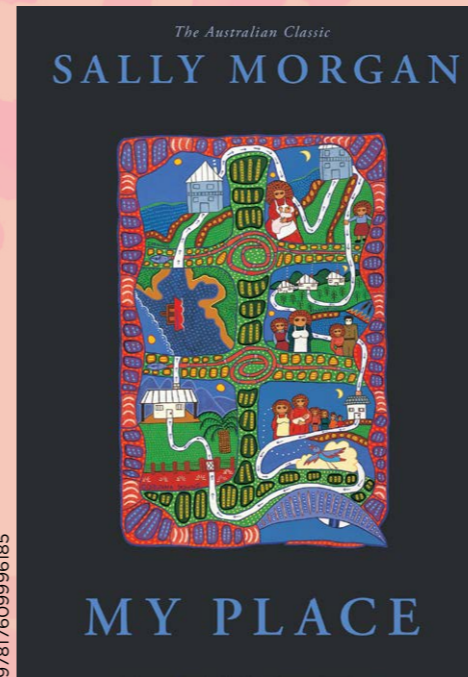

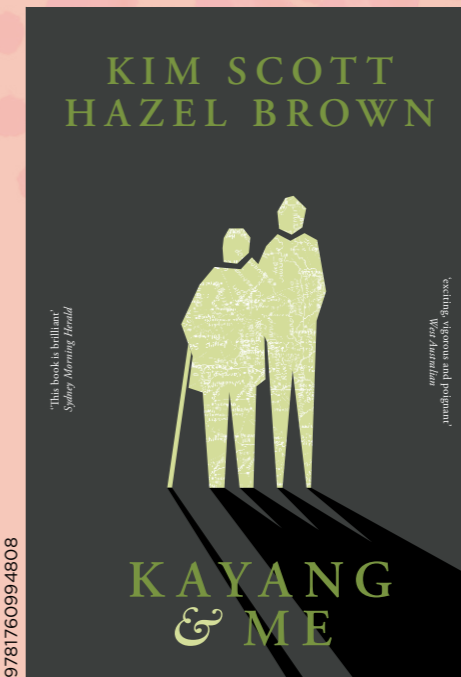
### MY PLACE

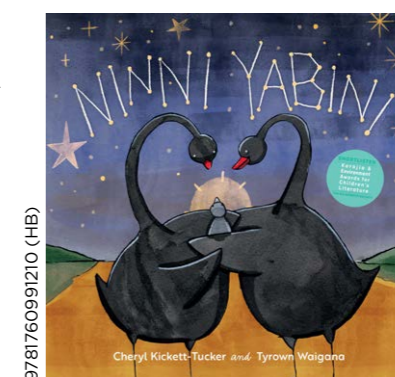
