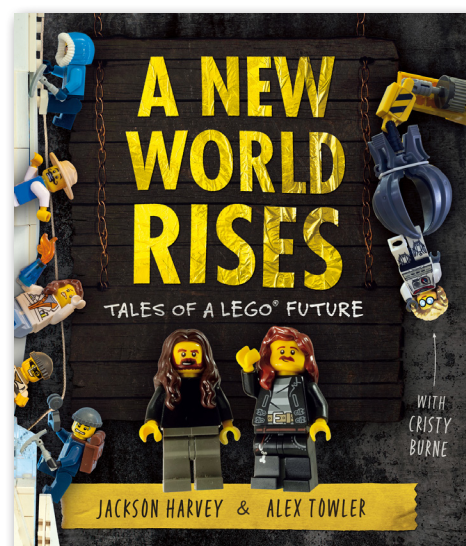
### ABOUT THE AUTHORS
