Patient four has lots of watery diarrhea, vomiting, thirst and leg cramps.

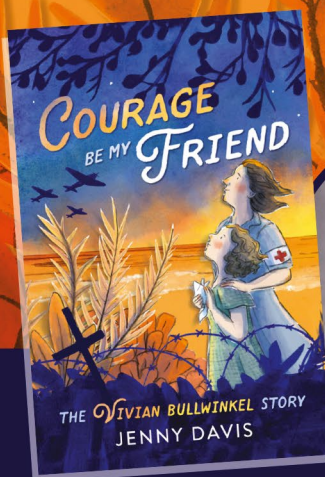
Your diagnosis:
