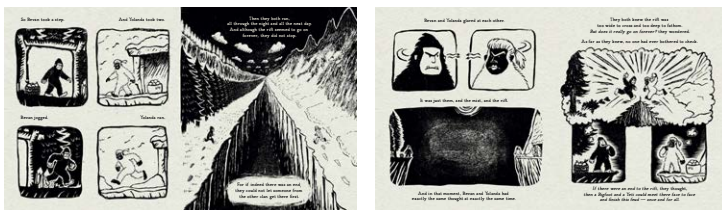


BIGFOOT VS YETI

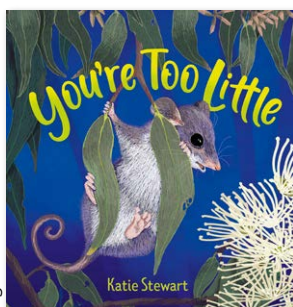

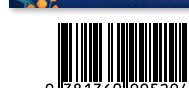
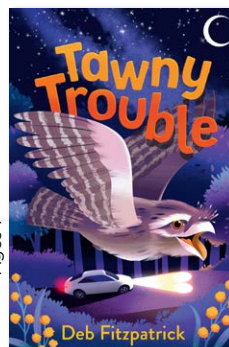
THE DEADLY DIAMOND

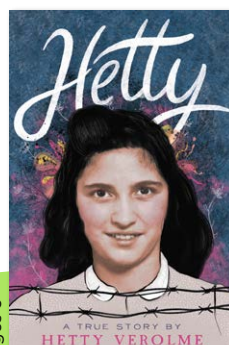
SOARING WITH THE SUGARBIRD LADY
