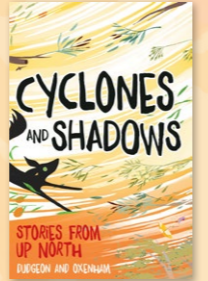
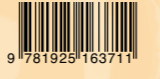


BLU AND THE LOST STORM
