He currently lives in Fremantle, WA, with his partner and 3 kids, and teaches creative writing at Curtin University.

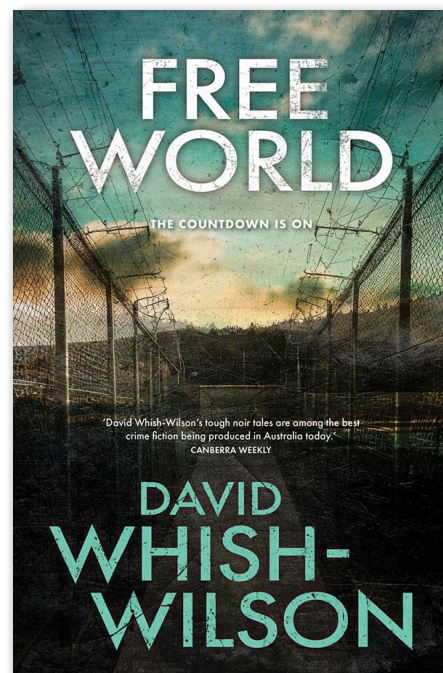


NOTES
