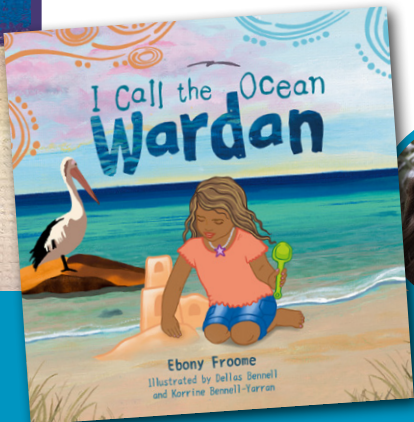


How is wardan special to you?

If you know its name in Noongar or any other language, ask an adult to help you write it next to your drawing.



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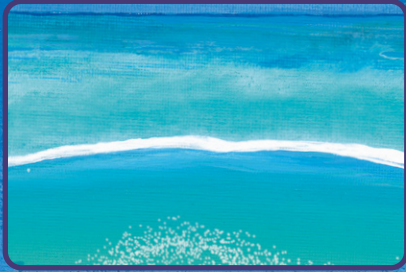


Learn an Indigenous Language

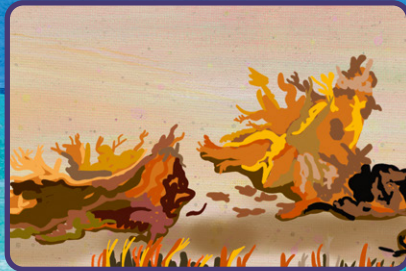

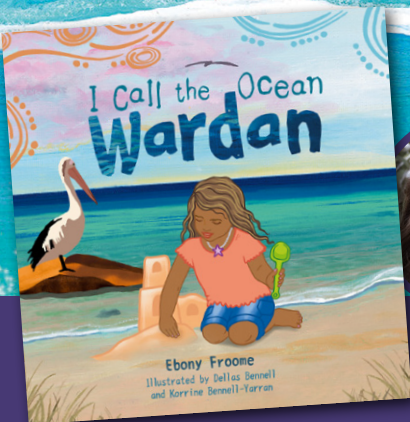
