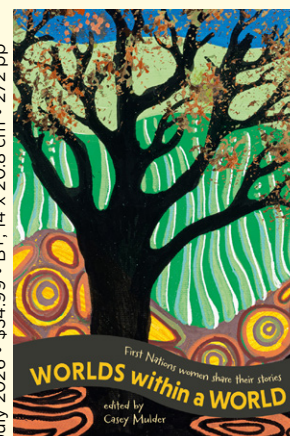
UNDER A BILARI TREE I BORN

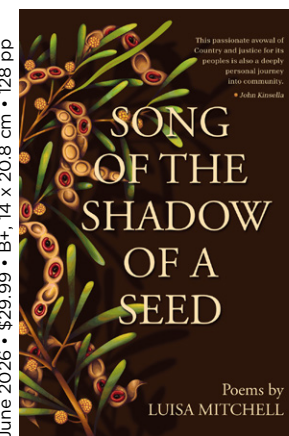
WHEN THE PELICAN LAUGHED
